## Information sheet n° C3: remonstration

## Your visa application has been denied?

If you want to object:

After disclosure of the denial of your application for a Schengen visa (short term stays), you may submit your remonstration letter within one month to the German Embassy Tbilisi. After disclosure of the denial of your application for a national visa (long term stays), you may submit your remonstration letter within one year to the German Embassy Tbilisi. You may submit the remonstration in person, via email, via mail or via fax.

Please note that processing of your remonstration may take several months. Often the Embassy has to deny a visa application, because the submitted documents do not suffice to substantiate the legal requirements for issuing the requested visa.

In case of Schengen/short term visas, you may submit a new application (after having booked a new appointment, cf. above) with complete and substantiated documents. In case of national/long term visas, you may also book a new appointment and submit a new application with the necessary documents. A new appointment conditions the mootness of your remonstration.

Your **letter of remonstration** must be submitted in **German** or **English** and, in any case, has to be **signed** by you **personally** or all legal guardians. Should you intend to submit your application by email, a scanned and signed letter of remonstration and a passport copy must be attached to your email. If you wish that another person submits the remonstration for you, this third person has to be duly authorized. The authorization must fulfill the same form requirements as the remonstration.

We ask for your understanding that inquiries about the current state of your remonstration will not be responded to, as those inquiries limit those capacities needed to evaluate your remonstration. Should your remonstration be approved, you will be contacted to submit your passport for issuing the visa. Should your visa application be denied again, you will be informed about the reasons for the denial again, in writing and in detail via an administrative decision. You may take action against this decision with the administrative court of Berlin.

## Which information should my remonstration letter contain?

We ask you to
☐ Always state your reference number (i.e. the last seven digits of the reference as given in the refusal decision).
☐ Give your full name and contact details (phone number, cell phone number, fax, email, mailing address)
<ul> <li>□ Give a statement regarding the short explanation you have been given in the refusal letter. Documents that you did not submit with your application should be submitted now.</li> <li>□ Present German translations for all documents (including the remonstration letter), if you remonstrate against the refusal of an application for a national visa, as German authorities may have to be consulted (again).</li> </ul>
You can assist in reducing the time for processing your remonstration by submitting your remonstration only via one option and thus avoiding duplication of the work.
<ul> <li>□ e.g.: If you send your remonstration via fax, please abstain from also sending it via mail or email.</li> <li>□ State your name and reference number on your letter/envelope.</li> </ul>
<ul><li>□ Do not resend documents that have already been submitted with your original application.</li><li>□ Wait for a notification by the Embassy. The Embassy cannot acknowledge the receipt.</li></ul>
The Embassy avails itself to inform that lawyers or third persons may be consulted for submitting your remonstration. This, however, is not mandatory.
Important
<ul> <li>□ The Embassy reserves the right to request further documentation where deemed necessary.</li> <li>□ According to § 6 AufenthG, there is no legal claim to the issuing of a Schengen visa.</li> <li>□ Instead of submitting your remonstration, you may directly file suit with the administrative court Berlin, Kirchstraße 7, 10557 Berlin. Should the court reject your suit, the costs must be covered by you (§ 154 Section I VwGB)</li> </ul>
